







Wines - National Treasure of France

France has 8 major vineyard regions:

The most important red wine varieties are Merlot, Grenache, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Carignan, Cabernet Franc, Pinot Noir and Gamay.

The most important white varieties are: Ugni Blanc, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc. Melon de Bourgogne and Sémillon.



French cuisine - cultural heritage of France

French cuisine is delicate, light, sublime and fanciful.

The French consider their dishes and products to be part of the world heritage.

French cuisine is considered to be the best in the world, and France is the cradle of the culinary arts. In France, wine is served with most dishes.

According to the French, each good meal should be crowned with a piece of delicious cheese and a glass of good wine.

Breakfast

For breakfast, they usually eat a croissant, which is served with a lot of marmalade or butter. Another option is a wheat baguette dipped in butter, liquid chocolate or jam. This set must be accompanied by hot and aromatic coffee or hot chocolate, but more and more often also freshly squeezed orange juice. Other equally popular breakfast dishes in France include omelette du fromage, brioche and French toast.



Dinner

Lunch is eaten between 12:00 and 14:00. Most often it consists of two elements - a main course (meat or fish) and a dessert, but sometimes it can also be a three-course course (with starters).

An interesting fact is that the French do not eat soups for dinner, as is our Polish custom. The dinner meal is crowned with coffee, preferably strong and stimulating.

During lunch, offices and shops are closed. Employees eat a small dinner (lunch) at nearby bars and restaurants.



Supper

For the French, the most important meal of the day is lunch, eaten quite late, between 20:00 and 22:00. Dinner consists of three courses. Starters - soups, salads or terrines. Main course - fish, meat or poultry served with noodles, potatoes or rice, vegetables and sauce.

Finally, a dessert and / or cheese board and a glass of red wine are served.

The French eat the last meal of the day for a long time, often with family or friends.



Disneyland

The best place for kids.

Disneyland was founded in the early 90's of the twentieth century. It was built by a famous American company. The complex has a lot of attractions for children and adults, bars and restaurants, numerous shops and swimming pools.

Fairy-tale parades with famous cartoon and movie characters take place in Disneyland.

Catacombs

The catacombs are a network of corridors in former quarries up to 300 km long! The remains of about 6 million dead Parisians have been collected here.

In the dungeons, you can see facades made of human bones and skulls.

The catacombs are located underground, so every tourist should bring a flashlight.

Sightseeing is definitely not intended for children, nor for particularly sensitive people.

- The white wedding dress is a French tradition from 1499.




- In 1789, the first universal Declaration of Human Rights was created in France.
